I shou'd sooner have return'd thanks for your obliging letter but that I realy am so full of business at present that I've hardly time to eat, for what with my own family, & too many in the parish who' are ill of Agues & fevers I've full employ: besides my house affairs w:ch is not to be neglected: I do asure you I'me up every morning before seven, but can't say I take any great delight in walking about the house, for 'tis just as you left it; I hope all your good family is well & beg my humble service to them you may see I am in prodigious hast by not saying more then that I am
